- 2. The duration of your talk time is: 30 minutes
- 3. You should set at least 5 minutes time for QA
- 4. Please submit your PowerPoint/outline one month before the event, as they must reviewed by the UW Quality Control Officer and Planning Committee.
- 5. Make sure to discuss your 3 questions you had submitted during your talk.

- 3. Number of slides in presentation: maximum 40 slides for an hour, 20 for 1/2 hour
- 4. **Slides Content -** Educational guidelines as per ACCME please make sure to include the below in your slides. Attached you will find a copy of what you submitted earlier for your info.
 - 1. Title of your Presentation Slide: Should be same as what was submitted
 - 2. Disclosure Slide:
 - a. You are required to give your financial disclosure at the start of your presentation both verbally and within your presentation.
 - b. This slide should state I have the following financial relationships to disclose:

- 3. **CME Objectives Slide:** Should be same as what was submitted.
 - 1. Compare how risk factors for diabetes in South Asian populations differ from US (with majority Caucasian ethnicity)
 - 2. Discuss when to consider evaluating for T1DM in adult onset diabetes, T2DM in childhood onset diabetes, and pancreatic (Type 3c) diabetes
 - 3. Outline misconceptions patient (and their communities) have about T1DM and T2DM and how that can affect management

4. Content Slides:

- a. Content of slides should reflect the topic Indicated.
- b. Your will refrain from making recommendations, regarding products or services, unless all relevant products or services applicable to the same procedure or treatment are presented in an unbiased manner.
- c. If you decide to add more slides later if you will need to resubmit the presentation for review by UW.

5. Learning Outcomes Slide:

- a. Make sure that the answers to your questions will be discussed in your presentation.
- b. If you decide to change your questions , answers or feeder responses you will need to let us know by September 1st 2020, as we conduct a pre and post conference questionnaire and will have to update them in our survey
