

WAPI conducts Evaluation of the learners Knowledge in the following steps

Evaluation component - that measures the impact of the activity on the physician learners' knowledge, strategies/skills, performance, and/or patient outcomes; Every Speaker is asked to fill the following form

1. Speaker is asked to submit
 - a. pre-and post CME activity questionnaire to measure their success. Please highlight the correct answer and limit your possible answers to a maximum of 4 with only one correct answer. The others can be partially correct or wrong.
 - b. Feedback: Feedback: Please provide a detail feedback (MOC) requirements for above questions in three groups
 - **Correct Answers:** Rationale for correct answers with relevant citations?
 - **Wrong Answers:** which of the above answers are wrong. Why are they wrong,
 - **Partially correct answer:** which of the above answers are partially correct Why is this answer only partially correct,
2. These questions are fed into survey monkey and then designed to give the following results
 - a. Correct Answer, Percentage of correct answers
 - b. Feedback: Rationale for answers with relevant citations as supplied by the Speaker at the end of evaluation to the participant

Participation Threshold:

1. Learners complete answers to a quiz during or after EME Event.
2. Participation Threshold is set at 70%

Feedback:

1. Best answer to each question is discussed or shared, including rationale for correct answers with relevant citations at the end of the quiz.
